- interacting with students during class time

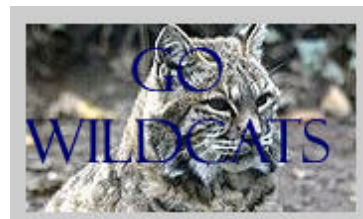
