

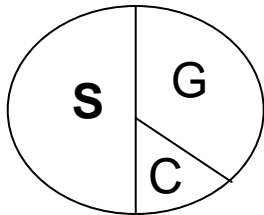
Where Do I Fit As A Leader?

Ministry Teams

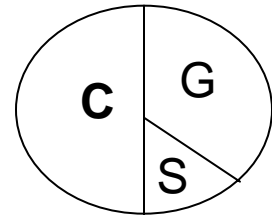
Pastors Focus on "Service Environments"



Example: "Leader Joe"

Joe's primary role is as a **Men's Small Group Table Leader** on Monday nights. He helps men connect in healthy Christian accountability relationships with each other as they *grow* in God's word and learn to *serve* others. He is an "L" in the DCLA structure and reports to the Men's Pastor. He is also playing a secondary leadership role working with the Missions Pastor to promote **Canning Hunger** which his Men's group does as a service outreach in their neighborhoods. Joe also works with the Assimilation Minister as he and his Men's group try to **welcome new men** into the church. Finally, Joe partners with the Teaching Pastor by encouraging his Men's group members to grow by attending the Believers Worship Service on Sundays so they are **worshipping corporately** with other believers.
